After eighty years of philanthropic endeavour on behalf of Greek migrants in Australia, AHEPA wishes to demonstrate the appreciation that Greek-Australian citizens feel for Australia, which welcomed, assisted and gave them a new homeland.

Chapter Thoron (Greek for 'Gift') was created for the purpose of establishing a process for donations of grants to the Australian charitable organisations of Brisbane, in the fields of Health, Education, Arts and Culture, Research and Science.
